Manual for Application for police for EU citizenship (2+1 pages):

you are supposed to write it in CAPITAL LETTERS, in **Slovak language**. So if you have some strange letters in your language, try to avoid them (your name is written in international letter on the bottom of the page of your passport). In the police office, they will copy it to computer, that's why it must be in readable form.

Here are some problematic numbers:

13. (if you are single) SLOBODNÁ (girls), SLOBODNÝ (boys),

18. ŠTÚDIUM,

- 20. the highest education you have finished: if you have finished your bachelor or master degree in university just write VYSOKOŠKOLSKÉ. if you have not finished any university degree and you are still working on it, write STREDOŠKOLSKÉ (S MATURITOU)
- 21. street, number of your house, town and postal code all written in our letters (international)
- 23. if you live at the address since you were born, write the date of your birth. If not, write the date when you moved in.
- 24. the same as 21 but you write it in your native language
- 29. address of your dormitory that you can find in the letter for police that you have got from the boss of dormitory.
